Dear friends and supporters of Eva Watt,
Greetings in our Lord from London, Ontario!

It has been my privilege to serve together with Eva during some of her years with SEND.

Next year, 2018, Eva will have completed her commitment to serve in Macau. She will be returning to Canada from her fulltime ministry there. Eva has done well in progression planning and has mentored a young man to take over her cloak of leadership and shepherding the flock entrusted to her. Together with her ministry team in China, we are somewhat saddened to have Eva Watt begin the departure process from full time over seas missionary service – she will be deeply missed in Macau as a career missionary!

As you may know, Eva Watt joined SEND international to work in the Canadian office in May 1985. However, in 1992 she felt the call to serve overseas in Hong Kong. She began serving with the Po Lam Church in Tseung Kwan O. Her supervisor in 2005 said this about her and I would suggest that the same is true of the congregation that she leaves in Macau. "When Eva joined this ministry, it was just a fledgling church plant, but it has developed and has now become a functional church. Perhaps no one knows the church as well as Eva, and she has worked very hard at this ministry and has endeared herself to the congregation."

Together with my colleagues in SEND Canada, I rejoice to see God's continuing work in Eva as she continues to commit herself to the Lord and His work. It is also with a great sense of peace and anticipation that we "turn the page" with Eva as she begins a new chapter of life and service. In May 2018, Eva will conclude fulltime over seas mission service and begin her 6 months home service where she desires to connect with many of her individual supporters and supporting churches. In November of 2018 Eva will move into a member care role whereby she can empathize, come alongside and care for SEND missionaries serving on the China field. Thank you, in advance, for your continuing to support of Eva with your prayers and finances as she begins this new phase of ministry in the fall of 2018. After October 2018 Eva's financial requirements will be reduced considerably. We will keep you apprised of those changes as they occur.

On behalf of SEND International, I want to express our sincere appreciation for your faithful friendship and ongoing support of Eva during her service with SEND. Many of you have prayed, given financially, and expressed love and care to enable the advance of God's work in Macau. As an organization, we are grateful to the Lord, and to you, His people. May He encourage your hearts through Eva's service, and continue to bring out His fruit from your important investments.
